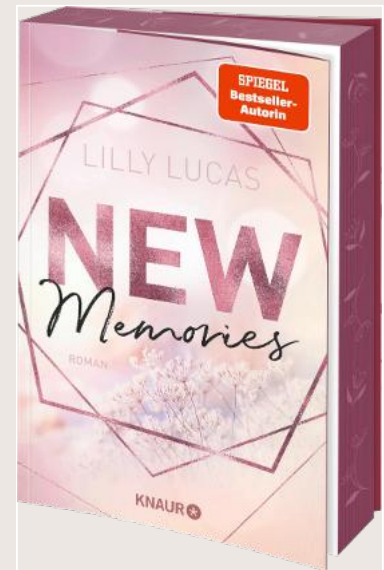

Is It Ever Too Late for a Truth That No One Believes in Anymore?

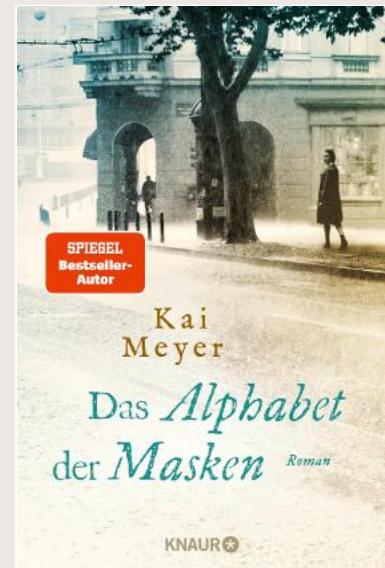
